Enrolment fee:

In the 2021/2022 academic year there will be an enrolment fee of 200 EUR per Intensive Music Week. This fee is not covered by the full scholarship and it must be paid to our euro bank account by the date specified.

The enrolment fee (200 EUR per intensive music week) is not refundable under any circumstances if the candidate cancels his/her participation. We therefore recommend that candidates take out a non-compulsory cancellation insurance.

In general, a full refund of the fees is only possible if an intensive music week has to be cancelled by the International Academy of Music in Liechtenstein.

Attendance:

In order to receive a full scholarship, all candidates must attend all five days of the Intensive Music Week at the Academy. Exceptions to this rule are only possible with the express permission of the Academy management.

Arrival: Check-in on the day before the beginning of the Intensive Music Week between 2.00 p.m. and 8.00 p.m.

Departure: Check-out on the day after the last day of the Intensive Music Week between 7.30 a.m. and 9.00 a.m.

Travel and board:

Each scholarship holder is responsible for his/her own travel arrangements to and from the student residence as well as for his/her catering requirements. These costs must be covered by the scholarship holder.

(There is a fully equipped kitchen available in the student residence, which can be used by participants.)

Accommodation:

Accommodation in the student residence is included in the full scholarship. The house rules of the student residence will be explained on the first day of the Intensive Music Week. These are binding for each and every scholarship holder.

(Rooms will be allocated by the Academy's management.)

Accompanying person:

Each young (minor) student can be accompanied by one person at the student home; however, the Academy must be given prior notice of an accompanying adult. The fee for the accommodation of an accompanying adult is 120 CHF per week.

Concerts:

Concerts organized as part of the Intensive Music Weeks are compulsory for each scholarship holder and will not be remunerated. If the Academy invites a scholarship holder to perform in a further concert, which is not part of the Intensive Music Weeks, the scholarship holder will receive an additional agreement for this performance. However, no scholarship holder is required to play at concerts organized by the Academy against his/her wishes. Sheet music:

The scholarship holder is responsible for preparing in advance and providing all sheet music (incl. scores) he/she requires during the Intensive Music Week. The repertoire must be sent in written form to the Academy's organization team (office@musikakademie.li) at least two weeks before the beginning of the Intensive Music Week.

Photographs, audio recordings and video recordings:

During our Intensive Music Weeks, we take photographs and make audio and video recordings for non-commercial use.

Video recordings made during the Intensive Music Weeks and concerts will be uploaded onto the Academy's website. Each scholarship holder can decide himself/herself whether individual videos are made available for public viewing online. (This setting can be found in his/her website profile.)

Biography:

The scholarship holder must include the following sentence in his/her biography for two years after the last Intensive Music Week attended: "I receive(d) a scholarship from the International Academy of Music in Liechtenstein and participate(d) in the Intensive Music Weeks and activities offered by the Academy."
